What you should know about making hoax 999 calls

- All 999 hoax calls are traced and recorded
- Hoax call information is always given to the police for further action
- A convicted hoax caller could face a fine of £5,000 and/or 6 months imprisonment
- firefighters can risk their lives attending every incident, including hoax calls
- A fire engine cannot be in two places at the same time
- When our firefighters are attending a hoax call, they cannot be at a real emergency
